

UNIACTIVE LUNCHTIME BASKETBALL COMPETITION – terms and conditions

1. Acceptance of Terms

Participation in UniActive Lunchtime Basketball Competition indicates acceptance of these terms and conditions. All players, team managers, and spectators are expected to adhere to these rules.

2. Registration and Payment

- All players must register by 03 March 2025.
- Team nominations are due by 03 March 2025.
- The player registration fee of \$50 per player must be paid in full by 03 March 2025.
- The game fees of \$50 per team per week must be paid prior to the start of each game.
- No refunds will be provided once registration is confirmed unless the competitions is cancelled by the organisers.

3. Eligibility

- Players must be 18 years old.
- A team must consist of a minimum of 5 players and a maximum of 12 players.
- Each player must submit a completed waiver.
- All team lists must be submitted by 03 March 2025.
- There is no limit to the number of male or female players on a team.
- All players must be registered, and only registered players may play for the team.
- All team must sign in and provide proof of identity upon request before taking the court.

4. Code of Conduct

- Unsportsmanlike behaviour, including abusive language, violence, or deliberate fouls, will result in penalties, including potential suspension or expulsion from the competition.
- Respect for referees, officials, and other players is mandatory.

5. Game Rules

- Each game consists of two 14-minute halves, with a 5 minute half-time break.
- A running clock will start at the scheduled time of the game. The clock will not be stopped for fouls.
- Teams must be ready to play at their scheduled time. A grace period of 5 minutes will be allowed before forfeiture, and the winning team will be given the option to play the remainder of the game or not if the opposing team turns up after the 5-minute grace period.

6. Safety and Liability

- All participants play at their own risk. The organisers are not responsible for any injuries, accidents, or loss of personal belongings during the event.
- Teams must ensure players are in proper health to participate.

7. Venue Rules

- Smoking, alcohol and illegal substances are strictly prohibited at the venue.
- Participants and spectators must follow all venue rules and respect the property.

8. Prizes and Awards

- 1st Prize = \$100 Duck Bucks to spend at the UniBar or UniShop.
- 2nd Prize = \$50 Duck Bucks to spend at the UniBar or UniShop.
- Prizes will be awarded to the teams as announced at the end of the competition.
- Prizes are non-transferable and cannot be exchanged for cash.
- All participants receive two weeks free UniActive gym membership to access the 24/7 Innovation Campus gym, Wollongong Campus gym and the 50 metre swimming pool.

2. Registration and Payment

- All players must register by 03 March 2025.

3. Eligibility

- Players must be 18 years old.
- A team must consist of a minimum of 2 players and a maximum of 6 players.
- Each player must submit a completed waiver.
- All team lists must be submitted by 03 March 2025.
- There is no limit to the number of male or female players on a team.
- All players must be registered, and only registered players may play for the team.
- All team must sign in and provide proof of identity upon request before taking the court.

4. Code of Conduct

5. Game Rules

- Each match consists of the best of 3 games of 21 points.
- The side winning a rally adds a point to its score.
- At 20 all, the side which gains a 2-point lead first, wins that game.
- At 29 all, the side scoring the 30th point, wins that game.
- The side winning a game serves first in the next game.
- Teams must be ready to play at their scheduled time. A grace period of 5 minutes will be allowed before forfeiture, and the winning team will be given the option to play the remainder of the game or not if the opposing team turns up after the 5 minute grace period.
